## To Whom It May Concern,

Hereby, on behalf of CERTAZ LLC, we confirm that the below is the translation of the update posted on AZAK's official website regarding the legality and authenticity of certificates in Azerbaijan :

According to the Law of the Republic of Azerbaijan "On Accreditation in the Field of Conformity Assessment," certification bodies must comply with this law, the requirements of national and international accreditation standards, and technical regulations in their activities.

Additionally, under the Law of the Republic of Azerbaijan "On Standardization," voluntary conformity assessment is carried out by conformity assessment bodies based on accreditation requirements, normative documents adopted by the national standardization body, and relevant international standards.

In accordance with point 12.1 of the AZS 498:2022 standard "Conformity Assessment – Rules for Certification of Goods," adopted by the Azerbaijan Institute of Standardization, the issuance of conformity certificates (including suspension, restoration, revocation, or re-registration) must be carried out through a unified electronic portal (www.e-keyfiyyet.gov.az).

Individuals who violate the requirements of the aforementioned legislation are held accountable in accordance with the Civil Code, the Administrative Offenses Code, and the Criminal Code of the Republic of Azerbaijan.
